The primary order of business concerned the application update for the Bicycle Friendly Community (BFC) designation with the League of American Bicyclists (LAB) which is due on August 15h. Roswell is the first and only city in Georgia to have achieved the coveted status as a “Bicycle Friendly Community.” Several other cities in Georgia are currently applying for this designation. The League of American Bicyclists reviews the BFC applications every two years to review for status renewal,. We would like to upgrade our BFC designation from “Bronze” to “Silver” this year.

A detailed To Do list was created for the renewal process. These items are due to be completed by August 11<sup>th</sup> so we can update the application in time to meet the LAB deadline. Individuals assigned items to complete are to send them to Manny in lieu of Eric’s temporary absence.
